

Syllabus for first-year critical thinking seminar, Fall 2014 Texas A&M University at Qatar

Life in Qatar is changing rapidly – new skyscrapers rise up from the ground, new roads are built everywhere, and new people from other cultures bring their own fascinating traditions with them to Qatar. Interviewing older people about their ways of life in the past can help us understand the impact of all of these changes. This seminar will explore the worlds we live in through interviewing people about their past, which is a process also known as curating oral history. Students will present their findings at an oral history exhibition at the end of the semester.

This seminar focuses on understanding and applying critical thinking skills, especially in support of integrative and lifelong learning. Small course size allows a high level of interactivity via discussion and other group activities.

By the end of the term, students should be able to:

- Define oral history.
- Describe and implement techniques used to collect oral histories.
- Listen thoughtfully and objectively to stories of life in the past.
- Identify and discuss key themes in others' oral histories.
- Evaluate source materials from one or more communities in Qatar.
- Explain how oral history relates to particular problems or issues in Qatar.
