Project Two: Ideation Presentation

Genre: Oral Presentation with Slides (10 minutes max)

Primary Audience: Your fellow engineers, who are interested in what you've been doing so far and want

to provide helpful feedback

Due date: March 16 or 18, 2020

The purpose of this project is to start an informal discussion with your fellow engineers about the ideation process and the overall progress of your project so far.

- In your presentation, you should include the following information.
- · What problem you are trying to solve
- Several potential engineering solutions to the problem you identify
- Which design process(es) you used to generate potential solutions to your problem
- Which method(s) and/or criteria you are using to evaluate potential solutions to your problem
- Which aspects of your project you would like additional feedback on

While a brief introduction to your problem will be helpful for your audience, the focus of this presentation is (1) 2-3 key questions you want to discuss with your classmates and get their perspective on and (2) the information your audience needs to make an informed decision on those 2-3 key questions. If possible, include a design matrix or other visual representation of your decision-making process. You should pay attention to the design of your slides and strive for a presentation that is clear, interesting, innovative, and invites audience participation. Audience members are expected to respond with helpful feedback on the content of other groups' presentations.
